NIFTY – 24,206.90 (Daily Chart)



- In Friday's trading session, the Nifty opened with a huge gap up but failed to extend its bullish momentum, remaining range-bound for most of the session. Despite the lack of follow-through buying, the index managed to close on a positive note.
- On a daily scale, the index has formed a small bullish candle, helping it close above the 100 DEMA, which is a positive sign for the bulls. The RSI has rebounded from the midline, indicating improving momentum and renewed bullish confidence. However, one factor that warrants caution is the large unfilled gap created during Friday's session, which may attract profit booking or gap-filling attempts in the near term.
- **For Monday's trading session, 24,150 will act as the initial support level, while on the higher end, 24,230 will act as the initial resistance level.**

BANK NIFTY – 58,045.90 (Daily Chart)



- In Friday's trading session, the banking index opened with a huge gap up and gradually moved northward throughout the session, helping the index close on a strong positive note.
- On a daily scale, the index has formed a strong bullish candle, which helped it decisively breach and close above the 20 DEMA level. The RSI is gradually moving northward, indicating improving strength and bullish momentum in the index. However, the only cautious factor for the bulls is the large unfilled gap created during Friday's trading session, which may lead to a gap-filling move or profit booking in the near term.
- For Monday's trading session, 57,825 will act as the initial support level, while on the higher end, 58,260 will act as the initial resistance level.





DMART : Company's Q1 net profit up 11.3% year-on-year to ₹860.6 crore from ₹773 crore earlier. Revenue up 14.9% to ₹18,794 crore from ₹16,359 crore last year. EBITDA up 15.4% to ₹1,499 crore from ₹1,299 crore last year. EBITDA margin flat at 7.97% from 7.94%.

LTM : LTM reported a steady performance for the June quarter, consolidated revenue rose 2.8% sequentially to ₹11,608 crore from ₹11,291.7 crore. In dollar terms, revenue was broadly flat at \$1.22 billion, inching up 0.1% quarter-on-quarter to \$1,223.5 million.

HDFCBANK : The bank said it is seeking shareholder approval to raise up to ₹60,000 crore through Additional Tier-I bonds, Tier-II bonds and long-term infrastructure bonds via private placements.

POWERGRID : State-run on Friday (July 10) said it has been declared the successful bidder under the Tariff Based Competitive Bidding (TBCB) process for the "Transmission System for integration of Krishnagiri REZ Phase-I" project.

- The recycling industry is urging the government to abolish a duty on aluminium scrap. This removal will lower input costs for domestic manufacturers and recyclers. India currently imports most of its aluminium scrap to meet industrial demand. The secondary aluminium sector supports many jobs and contributes to the circular economy. Other major base metal scraps already enjoy duty-free import status in India.
- India and Canada concluded their third CEPA negotiation round in Ottawa. Both nations aim to finalize this comprehensive economic partnership agreement this year. Discussions covered trade in goods, services, and intellectual property rights. Bilateral trade targets fifty billion US dollars by the year 2030. This agreement seeks to strengthen economic ties between the two countries.
- India and New Zealand elevated their bilateral ties to a strategic partnership. Both nations aim to double bilateral trade between them by the year 2030. Prime Minister Christopher Luxon stated this will boost jobs and wages in New Zealand. Extensive discussions covered trade, defense, and cultural exchanges between the leaders. Several Memoranda of Understanding were exchanged following the productive talks.
