- On a daily scale, the index has formed a bullish candle but failed to breach the horizontal resistance level of 26,105. The index continues to hold its bullish structure, forming higher highs and higher lows. The only cautious sign for the bulls is that the RSI is trading in the overbought zone.
- For Thursday's trading session, 26,105 will act as an initial resistance level, and on the lower end, 26,020 will act as an initial support level.

- On a daily scale, the index has formed a small bullish candle with a long wick at the bottom, indicating recovery from lower levels. The index continues to hold its bullish structure, forming higher highs and higher lows. The only cautious sign for the bulls is that the RSI is trading in the overbought zone.
- For Thursday's trading session, 58,305 will act as an initial support level, and on the higher end, 58,475 will act as an initial resistance level.

LT: Engineering and construction major Larsen and Toubro (L&T) reported 16% YoY growth in its consolidated net profit at Rs 3,926 crore in the second quarter on top of 10% jump in its revenues at Rs 67,984 crore. EBITDA for the quarter improved 7% YoY to Rs 6,806 crore, while margins declined slightly to 10%

VBL: Varun Beverages Ltd (VBL), a key bottling partner of PepsiCo, on Wednesday announced a major expansion plan that includes entering the alcoholic beverage segment in Africa and establishing new operations in Kenya. The unit will handle the manufacturing, distribution, and sale of beverages in the region.

BHEL: State-owned Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd (BHEL) said its consolidated net profit more than tripled to Rs 374.89 crore in the September quarter compared to a year ago, mainly on the back of higher revenues. The company had a consolidated net profit of Rs 106.15 crore in the quarter ended on September 30.

ECONOMIC NEWS

- Federal Reserve is widely expected to announce a 25 basis point (0.25%) rate cut today, lowering the federal funds rate target range to 3.75%–4.00%. This decision is nearly a done deal as the Fed navigates uncertainties from a weakening labor market and ongoing federal government shutdown that limits economic data. Jerome Powell, the Fed Chair, is scheduled to announce the decision at 2:00 PM Eastern Time today, Wednesday, October 29, 2025. The Fed is likely to remain cautious in its guidance, keeping future rate moves open, as officials are divided on the pace of cuts. There may be some dissent with at least one official favoring a larger cut of 50 basis points.India's crude oil imports from the United States surged in October to their highest point since 2022. This increase is driven by favorable economics and India's strategy to diversify its oil sources. Refiners are booking more US grades to balance supply security and geopolitical considerations. Russia remains India's top supplier, but the US share is growing.
- The US and Singapore collectively contributed over a third of India's Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in 2024-25, as per the Reserve Bank of India's latest census. Other significant sources of FDI included Mauritius, the UK, and the Netherlands. The census covered cross-border liabilities and assets of Indian entities.
